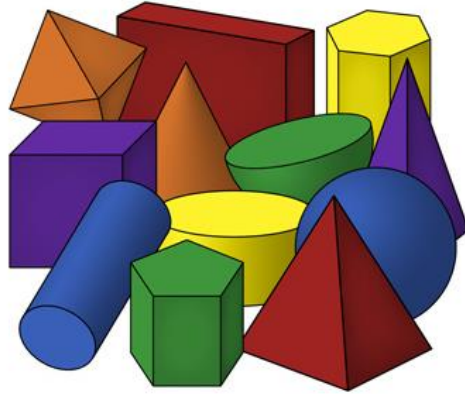


# Duck Extended Day Notes

## March



Shape and color recognition helps children define the world around them. It helps them compare, sort, categorize and identify objects. Our Montessori materials such as metal inset shapes, geometric solids, constructive triangles, red rods, etc. provide hands on experience and aide in learning shapes. This month we will go on a shape exploration with the study of 1, 2 and 3-dimensional shapes. After naming and categorizing shapes, we will understand how letters and numbers are formed from lines and shapes. Shape hunt, shape stamp and paint, shape collage, shape matching and sorting, are few of the activities on the list.

We will make shape poses in our yoga class and will bake shape cookies.
