SHOW AND TELL – FRIDAY, JUNE 14th

Our stories, art, and science lessons will revolve around insects and arachnids. We are encouraging the children to bring in a book, photo or drawing of one of their favorite insects for show-n-tell on Friday. Other ideas are a plastic or stuffed insect or a live insect in a jar.

The morning outdoor playtime takes place before class time in the summer to take advantage of the cooler temperatures. Please be sure that your child is on time for the beginning of class; the **staffed car line** operates from **8:25 until 8:35**.

We recommend applying sunscreen BEFORE arriving at MSCU each day. We are happy to reapply sunscreen later in the day. Please label the sunscreen you choose to send with your child's full name.

WATER SPRINKLER DAY FOR FULL DAY STUDENTS – STARTING WEEK 2

Wednesday afternoon (approx. 3:00-3:30) will be Water Sprinkler Day for our *students who are enrolled in the full day program*. Elementary students will be on the South side of the school playground area while our Primary students will be on the North side of the school playground area.

Please allow your child to bring a swimsuit and a towel in a labeled plastic bag. Bags with wet towels and suits will be sent home that afternoon.

Children who do not have swimsuits will not be allowed to play in the sprinkler; however, they may play in another area of the playground during sprinkler time and participate in other water play activities.

Also, please send sunscreen on the day assigned to your child.

SKATELAND ADVENTURES FOR FULL DAY STUDENTS – STARTING WEEK 2

Primary children will be going on Tuesday afternoons, beginning Tuesday, June 11th. Elementary children will be going on Friday afternoons, beginning Friday June 14. No fee is required, as it was included in your summer tuition fee.

Children will be walking with supervision, so if you would like to volunteer to join -please watch for a Sign-Up Genius registration in your email. We will leave MSCU at 2:30 pm and will return by 4:30 pm. On days when the heat index is 100f or above, or storms/rain are present -the children will not

go. Please be sure your child has a pair of socks in their backpack if they are not wearing them to school.

JUNE AND JULY TUITION IS DUE

HEAT INDEX DAYS

The children will go outside daily to play, unless the heat index reaches triple digits. At that point, they will continue to be inside.

PARENT-STAFF COMMUNICATION

If you need to talk with your child's teacher regarding your child's weekly progress, please leave a note in the Directress' mailbox. A time will be arranged, out of the children's presence, when the staff is not responsible for monitoring the children or carrying out staff duties. This is for the safety of all of our children. We wish daily reports were possible, but our attention must be child-directed. The staff will notify you if there is any problem or concern. We thank you for your understanding and cooperation.

CIRCLE DRIVE DIRECTIONS

Please **do not park or leave your car unattended** in the circle drive. This is a fire lane that must be kept clear in case of emergencies. Feel free to park on the street. We ask that you use the sidewalks to make a safer environment for our families. Thank you for your cooperation!

EXTRA SET OF CLOTHING

Each child is required to have an extra set of seasonal clothing to be kept at school in case of bathroom or water activity accidents -2 sets of extra clothing is even better. If wet clothing is sent home, please send replacements the next day.
