#### DROP OFF AND PICK UP

Please do not leave your car in the circle drive when you are picking your child up. This tends to slow down the pickup process for the remaining children. This is a fire lane, as well.

If you are walking children into school, please park on the street. It is difficult for drivers to see students walking to the building. Do NOT walk across the driveways or parking lot! Utilize the sidewalks and hold your child's hand. We promote independence...but not over safety! Please be aware of vehicles when crossing the street!

## **EXTRA SET OF CLOTHING**

Please be sure your child has an extra set of clothing at the school. With all of the wet and cold weather, it's possible that they may need to change into dry clothing before they go home. In addition, there needs to be an extra set in the event of an accident. Thanks!

## **SNOWY, WET, RAINY WEATHER**

Reminder: please send your child with snow boots, snow pants, and waterproof gloves every day. We all go outside to play if the "feels like" temperature is 17 degrees Fahrenheit or above. Even if there is no snow outside, having snow pants, snow boots and waterproof gloves can make off the difference between a happy child and a cold, shivering child during outdoor playtime. Having the right equipment helps our students enjoy their outdoor play.
